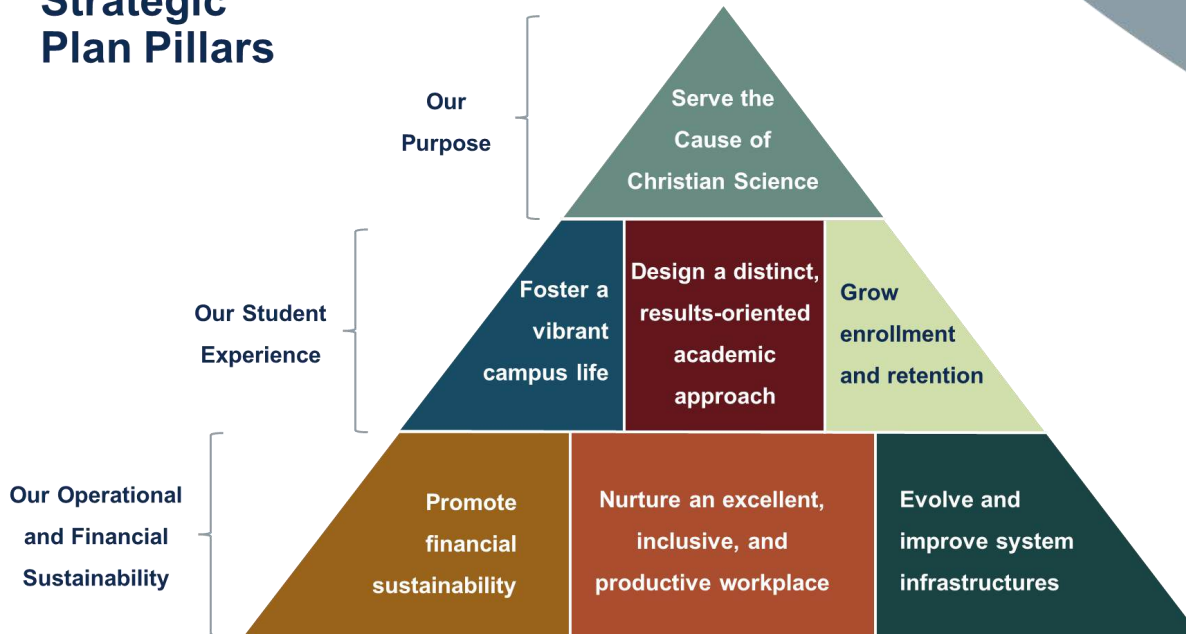

In support of these key goals, we have identified additional areas of impact essential to achieving them:

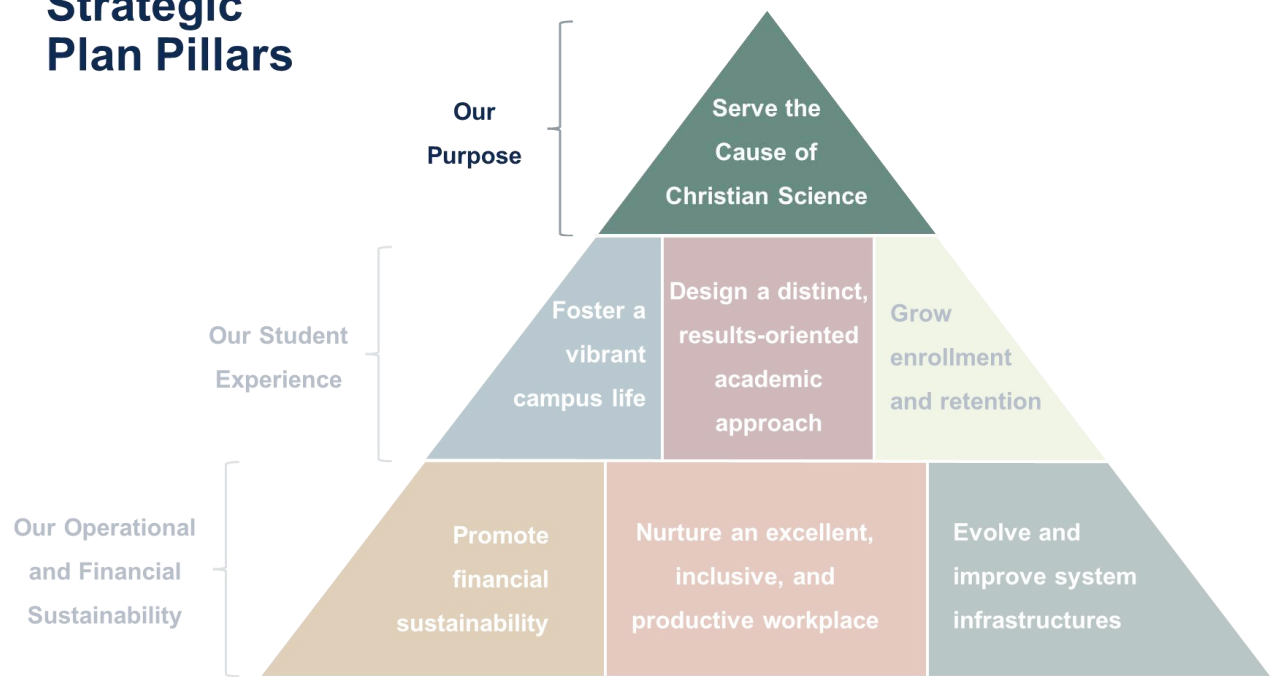
1. Cultivate a dynamic, inclusive, and productive workplace, fostering engagement and high performance
